Let's Find Out About It:

Preparation: *Set up materials.*

“In <i>The Little Red Hen (Makes a Pizza)</i> , how did the Hen and her friends cooperate ?”	Show illustrations. Children respond.
“In <i>Hooray, a Piñata!</i> , how did Clara, her parents, and her friend Samson prepare - get ready - for her birthday celebration ?”	Show illustrations. Children respond.
“What expectations - things you think will happen - should we agree to so that our celebration is successful? How can we be kind, respectful, and helpful?”	Write and draw simple illustrations of children's responses on chart paper for reference. Children respond.
