Incidents and Dispositions

The Unsafe School Choice Option (**Section 8532, 20 U.S.C. 7912**), mandated by the **Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965**, as reauthorized under the **Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015** (ESSA), requires that each state receiving funds under the ESSA establish and implement a statewide policy *requiring that a student who attends a "persistently dangerous" public school, as well as a student who becomes the victim of a violent criminal offense* while in or on the grounds of any public school that he or she attends, be allowed to attend a safe public school.

Incidents and Dispositions

- **Rule 38.1. School violence reporting.**
- The State Board of Education is implementing the requirements of Section 37-11-29, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended 1994, which requires the development of a form to report school violence; the required form is attached. State Department of Education staff shall develop guidance materials to assist school districts in reporting school violence. Report immediately (without delay) to: City Police or Sheriff's Office and Youth Court. See Mississippi AG Opinion, Preston (April 11, 2003), and Section 37-11-29 (3.) Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended. Incidents and Dispositions

Two Divisions

- **Incident** is an infraction committed by a student
- **Disposition** is the result of an incident and is prescribed by the district

- Persistently Dangerous Criteria in Part II has a 72 hour reporting requirement
- Part III & IV are monitored by Safe and Orderly Schools, however, are required as monthly reporting requirements

Incidents and Dispositions

- Persistently Dangerous School is a school that, during the past two (2) years, has continually exposed its students to injury from violent criminal offenses and is
 - An elementary, middle or secondary public school in which a total of 20 or more violent criminal offences were committed per 1000 students (2%) in two (2) consecutive years
 - An elementary, middle, or secondary alternative school in which a total of 75 or more violent criminal offenses were committed per 1000 students (7.5%) in two consecutive years

Incidents and Dispositions

- "Violent criminal offenses" are the following crimes reported in the Mississippi Student Information System:
 - Simple or Aggravated Assault
 - Homicide
 - Kidnapping
 - Rape
 - Robbery
 - Sexual Battery
 - Mayhem
 - Poisoning
 - Extortion
 - Stalking
 - Seizure and Forfeiture of Firearms

Supplemental

- Whenever the State Board of Education has information that a school meets the criteria described in paragraph 1.a (i) or 1.a (ii), the State Board of Education shall provide the local board of education the opportunity to report on conditions in the school. After consideration of that report and consultation with a representative sample of local educational agencies, the State Board of Education shall determine whether the school is a persistently dangerous school. **Once a school has been designated a persistently dangerous school, it retains that designation for at least one school year.**

Supplemental

- Students assigned to a school which the State Board of Education has determined to be persistently dangerous shall be allowed to attend another school in the LEA which is not designated a persistently dangerous school, provided there is such a school in the LEA which offers instruction at the student's grade level.
- Any student who is the victim of a violent criminal offense committed against him or her while he or she was in or on the grounds of the public school that he or she attends shall be allowed to choose to attend another school in the LEA which is not designated a persistently dangerous school, provided there is such a school in the LEA which offers instruction at the student's grade level and provided the student requests transfer within 30 days of the violent criminal offense.

Supplemental

- Under the *Every Student Succeeds Act*, school districts are required to notify parents if their child is eligible for school choice because his or her school has been identified as needing improvement, corrective action or restructuring. They must notify parents no later than the first day of the school year following the year for which their school has been identified for improvement.
- States are required to ensure that school choice is offered as an option to parents in the event their child is attending a school that is "persistently dangerous" or has been the victim of a violent crime while on school grounds.

Supplemental

- Local school systems *shall establish a process for assuring any student who has the right to transfer* from a school under this policy is allowed to transfer to a school in the LEA, which is not persistently dangerous. The process must be included in the system's Safe School Plan.
- The LEA shall report each student transfer effected pursuant to this policy to the State Board of Education in the Mississippi Student Information System.

(b) CERTIFICATION — As a condition of receiving funds under this Act, a State shall certify in writing to the Secretary that the State is in compliance with this section.
