

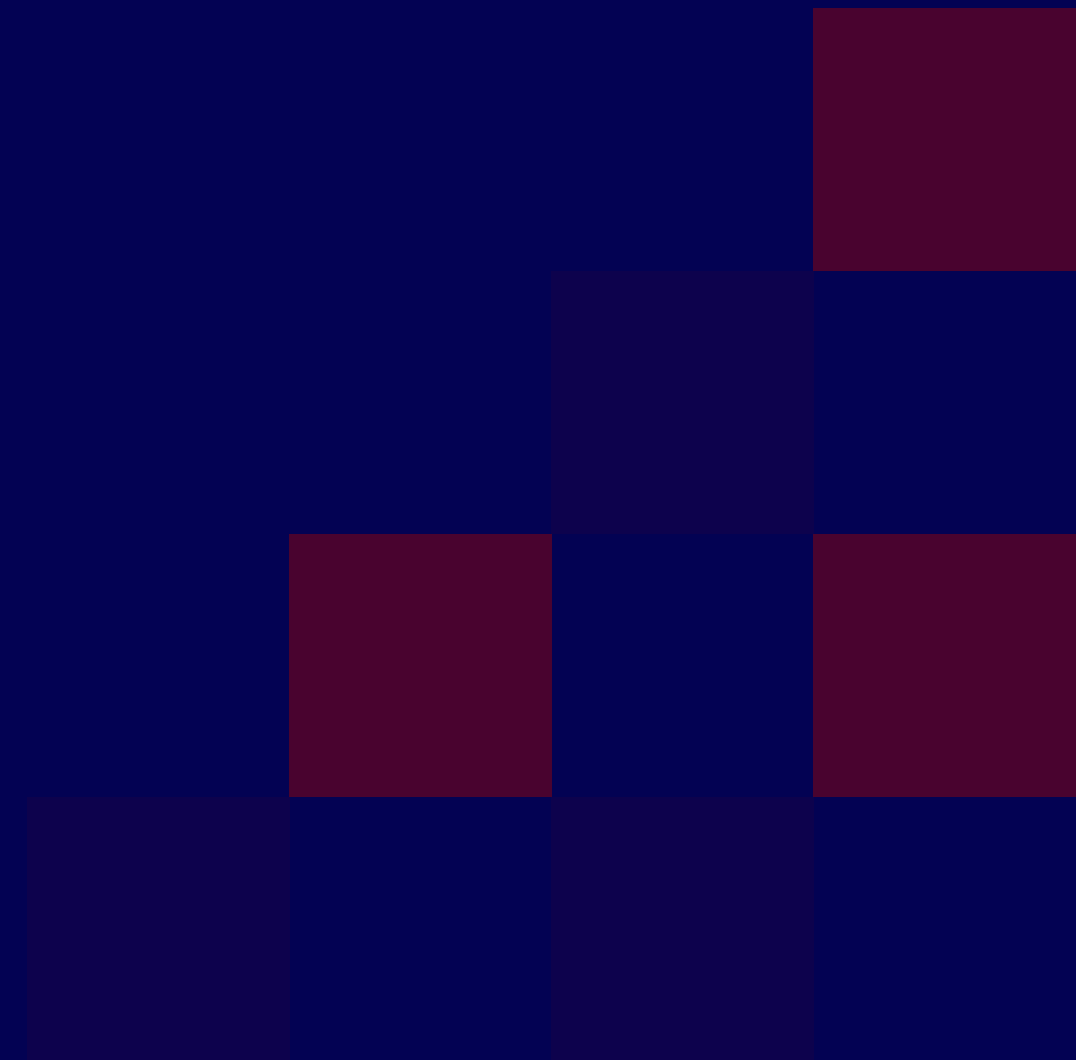



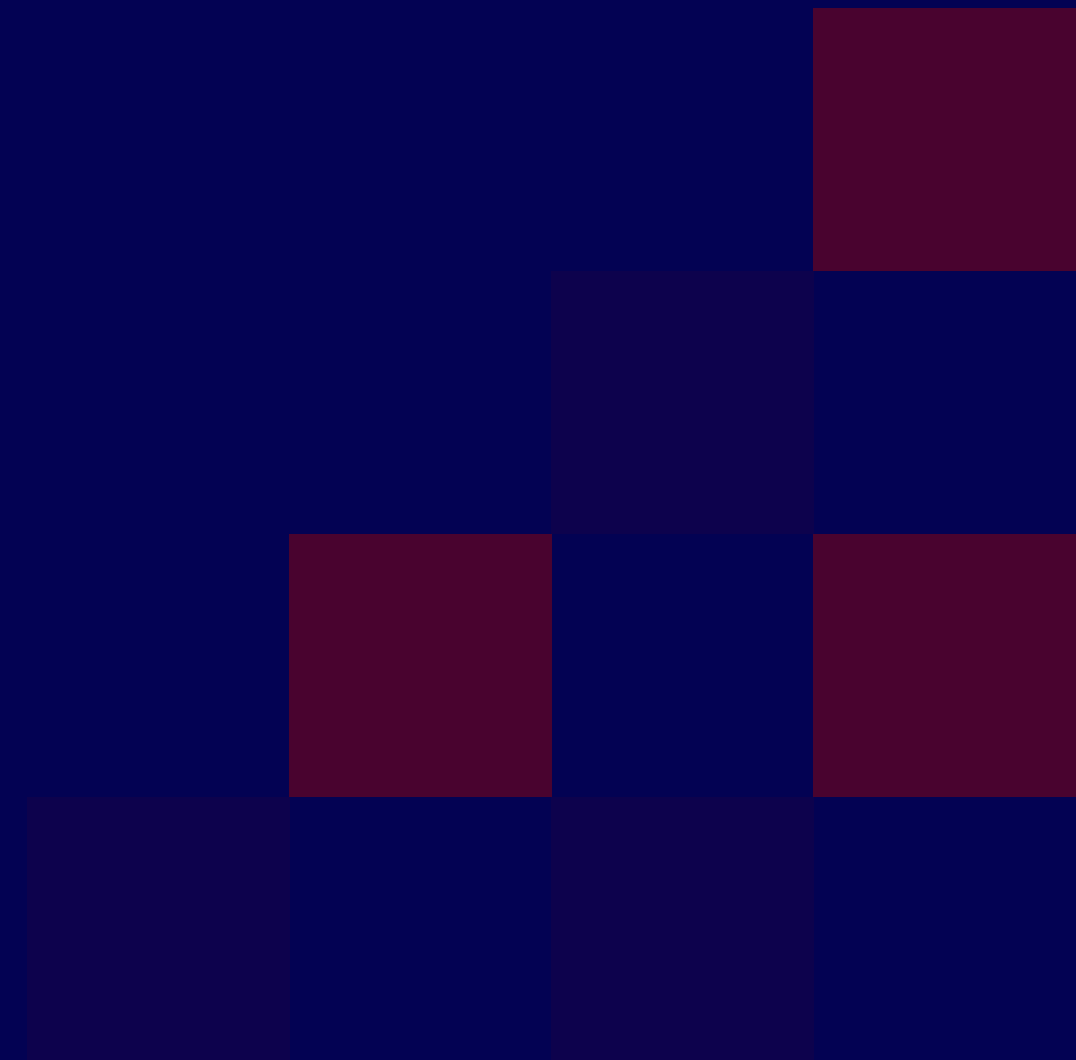
School Year

Virtual Learning

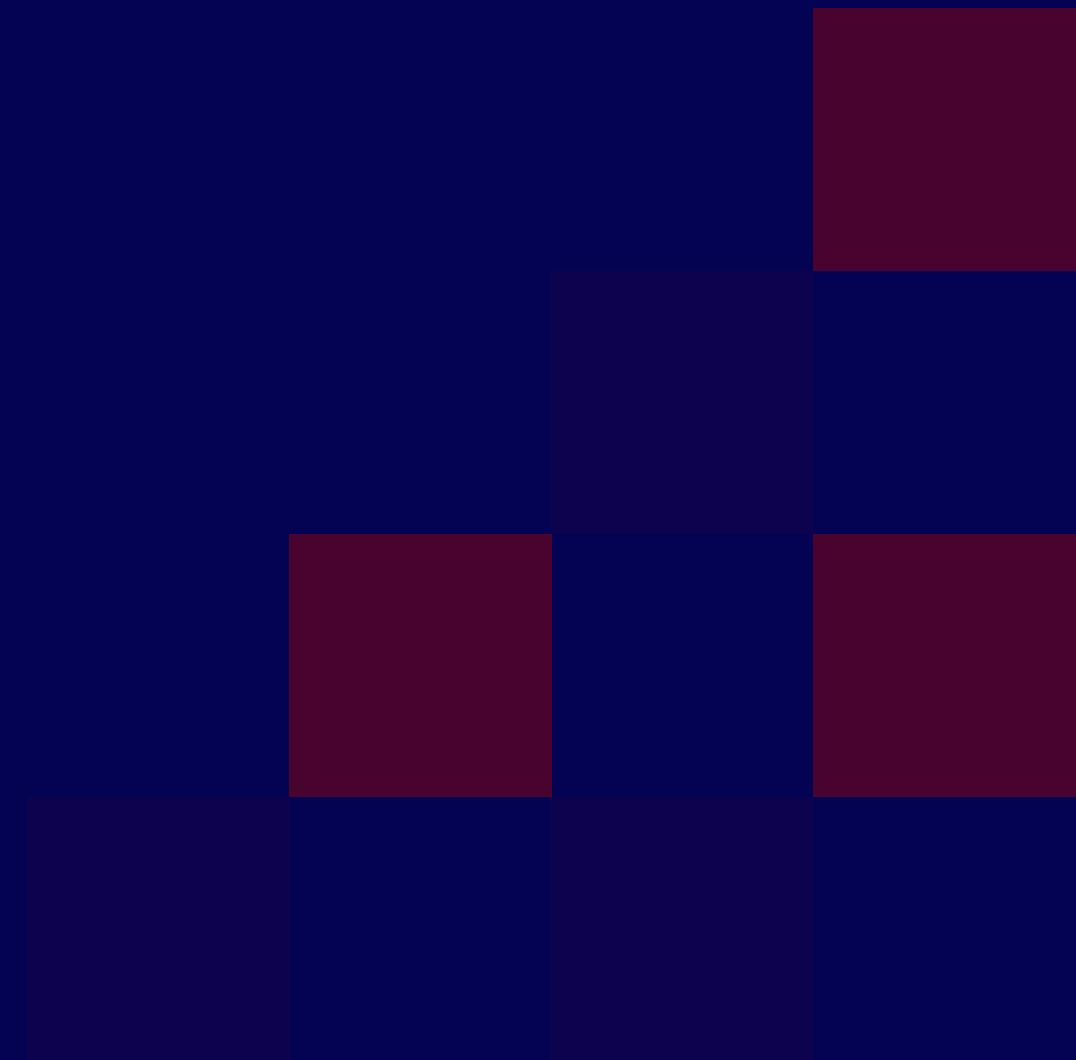
Virtual learning options have been suspended for the 2021-2022 school year.

Exemption Policy 2021-2022 School Year



1:1 Technology Devices

- Every student will have access to an iPad. Grades K-4th grade will leave the devices at school initially. Grades 5-12 will take devices home each day.
- Technology fee per student = \$25

- Focused, data-driven interventions will be provided for students throughout the school year
- Support services such as special education, dyslexia, speech and language will be provided

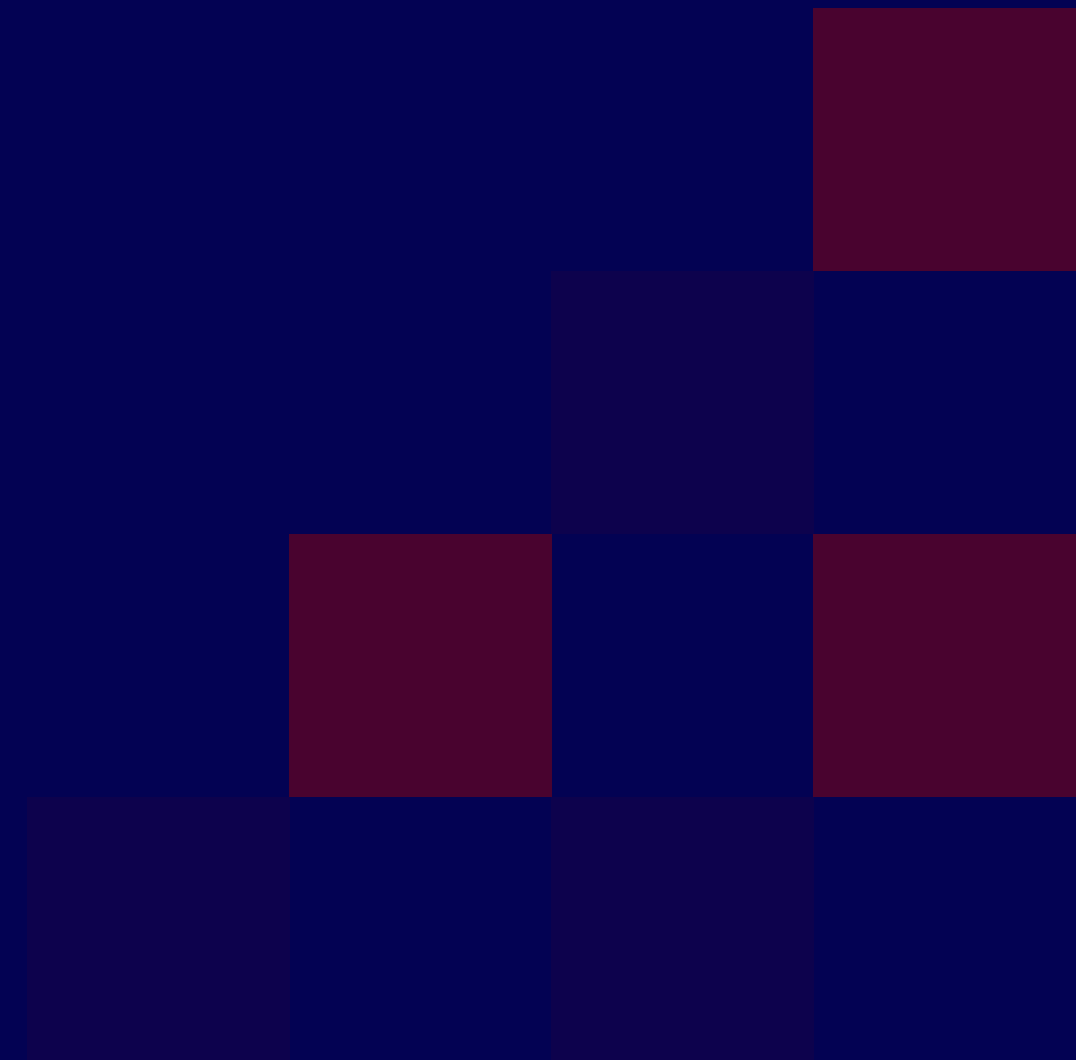

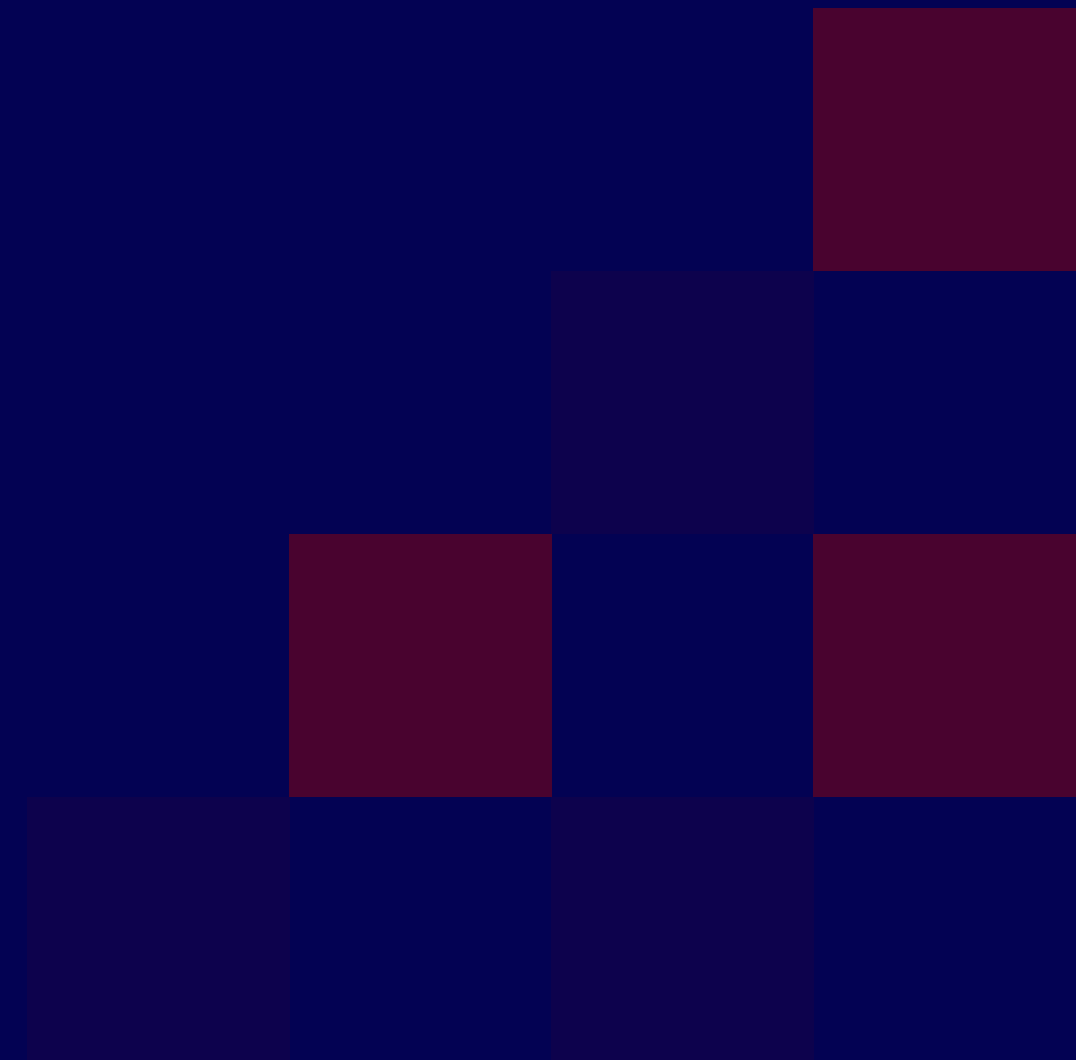

- The district will make all possible measures to promote social distancing. However, despite the district's best efforts, there will be times where students will be closer than 6 feet to another person.

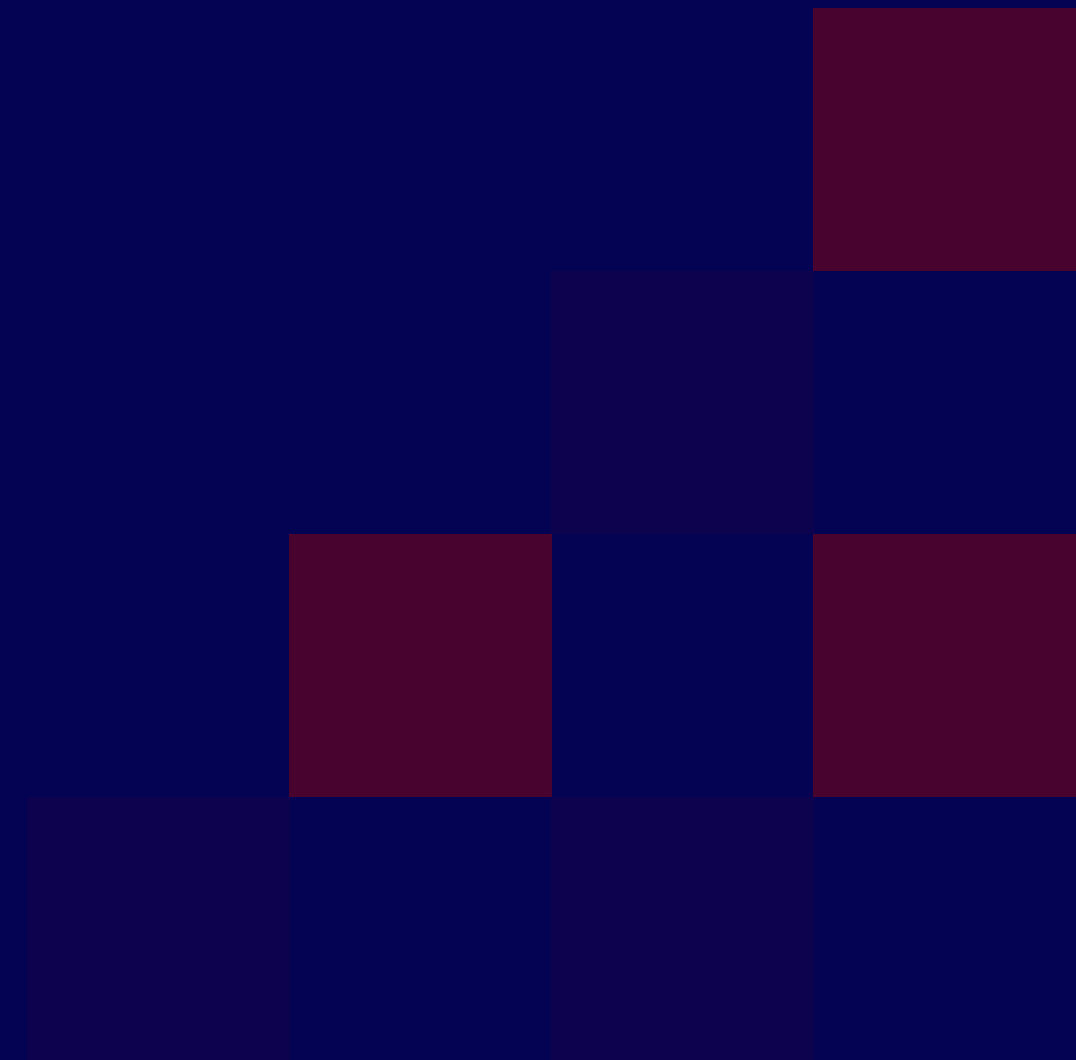
Face Masks
