12. <u>Approval to award competitive grants for the Education for Homeless Children and Youth Program</u>

<u>Purpose</u>: Grants are awarded to local educational agencies to provide services for homeless children and youth (including pre-school age children) that enable them to enroll, attend, and succeed in school. These services include before and after school tutoring, supplemental instruction, and enriched educational activities. Activities may be provided on school grounds or at other facilities including sectarian property.

• Grant Period: September 1, 2012 – November 30, 2013

(with a 90 day liquidation period ending

February 28, 2014)

Award Amount: \$638,752.01

Method of Award: Request for Proposals

<u>Funding Source</u>: Federal (Title X, Part C, Subtitle B of the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act*, as amended by the *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001*).
