**OFFICE OF ACCREDITATION**

05. Approval of the Corrective Action Plan for districts assigned a PROBATION or WITHDRAWN status in accordance with Accreditation Policy 2.8.1

In accordance with Accreditation Policy 2.8.1 of the *Mississippi Public School Accountability Standards, 2014*, a school district that has been assigned a PROBATION or WITHDRAWN accreditation status must submit a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) with defined timelines in which to correct the district's deficiencies. In accordance with Policy 2.8.1, the State Board of Education implements the program of development in each district in accordance with Section 37-17-6(10), Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended.

Four districts have been assigned a PROBATION status:

- A. Coahoma County Agricultural High School
- B. Wayne County School District
- C. West Bolivar Consolidated School District
- D. Leake County School District.
