04.F. Action: Award competitive grants for the McKinney-Vento Education for Homeless Children and Youth Program [Goals 1 and 2 – MBE Strategic Plan]

Background and Purpose: The McKinney-Vento program is designed to address the problems that homeless children and youth have faced in enrolling, attending, and succeeding in school. Grants are awarded to local educational agencies to ensure that homeless children, including preschoolers and youth, receive a free and appropriate public education and support services to eliminate barriers to academic success. Services will include but are not limited to the provision of supplemental instruction, transportation, free school meals, enriched education services, social services, and medical referrals.

Scope of Grant:

- Grant Period: August 1, 2024 – September 30, 2025
(With a liquidation period ending December 30, 2025)
- Award Amount: \$1,260,936
- Method of Award: Request for Proposals

Funding Source: Title IX, Part A – McKinney-Vento Education for Homeless Children and Youth of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 of the *Every Student Succeeds Act*

Summary of Selection Process:

A competitive grant selection process was utilized to award grants.
