## Chapter 84: Vocational, General Administration (Career and Technical Education)

Rule 84.7 Designation of Agents for the Delivery of Career and Technical Education Services. The delivery of all career-technical education programs, projects, services, etc. shall be through the public secondary schools and facilities, community/junior colleges, and special other state institutions.

The delivery of professional development, training, and teacher education activities shall be through appropriate delivery systems.

The delivery of research, curricula, industry training materials, teacher education activities, and specialized professional development services shall be through the Research and Curriculum Unit for Career and Technical Education at Mississippi State University.an appropriate regional vocational-technical facility, defined as exhibiting an emphasis in and proven record of vocational and/or career and technical education expertise in curriculum development, assessment, teacher training, and continued professional development.
