<u>Background and Purpose</u>: The purpose of the K-8 STEM Initiative Enhancement Project is to establish and/or enhance existing STEM-related programs in Kindergarten through 8th grade. This grant supports implementation of STEM activities in classrooms and coursework, while providing technology upgrades and educator training to implement STEM applications. Priority was given to schools implementing engineering, computer science, robotics, and other project-based STEM activities to expand the current Mississippi College- and Career-Readiness standards for math and/or science K-8.
