B. <u>Approval to revise the methodology to award grants to school districts, to</u> <u>participate in the State Systemic Improvement Plan</u>

<u>Background and Purpose</u>: The Office of Special Education has developed a State Systemic Improvement Plan (SSIP) that is based on building capacity of the local school districts using evidence-based practices in reading with a focus on improving third grade reading proficiency. The purpose of the grant is to provide funding for half the salary plus benefits, up to \$35,000, for literacy coaches in local school districts.

<u>Eligibility</u>: Any school district in the state of Mississippi that has not been awarded a SSIP grant is eligible to apply for these funds.

Funding Source: Federal funds

Basis for Awarding the Grants: Competitive

Funds will be awarded based on the following methodology:

- Districts will be recruited through a competitive process
- Grant awards will be in the amount not to exceed \$35,000 for the purpose of salary and fringe benefits
- Grant awards may be granted up to five years based on end-of-year evaluation and availability of funds
