## OFFICE OF ACADEMIC EDUCATION

02. Action: Approval to submit an Addendum to the ESEA Consolidated State Plan due to the COVID-19 National Emergency and an accompanying waiver request for the identification of Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) schools based on 2020-21 results [Goals 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 – MBE Strategic Plan]

The MDE requests approval from the SBE to submit an Addendum to the ESEA Consolidated State Plan, as well as a waiver request regarding the identification of TSI schools due to the COVID-19 National Emergency.

As a part of this submission to the United States Department of Education (USDE), the MDE is proposing the following:

- Timelines for long-term goals will shift forward by one year for academic achievement, graduation rate, and progress toward English language proficiency (ELP).
- 2. The ELP indicator will be excluded from calculations for the 2020-21 school year, and ELP indicator points will be redistributed to all other components in the model.
- 3. School and district letter grades, as required by state law, will not be assigned based on 2020-21 assessment results, but rather letter grades from the 2018-19 school year will remain in place.
- 4. Timelines for identification of schools for school improvement will shift forward to 2022-23 (based on data from 2021-22).

<u>NOTE</u>: According to ESSA, TSI schools must be identified annually. MDE will submit a waiver request indicating that TSI identification in the fall of 2021 will be based on data from the 2018-19 school year.

5. Comprehensive Support and Improvement schools identified for graduation rate may exit after the 2020-21 school year if exit criteria are met.

This item references Goals 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of the *Mississippi Board of Education 2018-2022 Strategic Plan*.
