J. <u>Approval of methodology to award grants to school districts for costs associated</u> with the COVID-19 pandemic impact on Pre-K classrooms

<u>Background</u>: In accordance with Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER Fund). Under the ESSER Fund, established as part of the Education Stabilization Fund in the CARES Act, State educational agencies (SEAs) will award subgrants to local educational agencies (LEAs) to address the impact that the Novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) has had, and continues to have, on elementary and secondary schools across the Nation. MDE was able to retain 9.5% of its ESSER Fund grant (the "SEA Reserve"), to address emergency needs from COVID-19, which may be addressed through the use of subgrants or contracts.

<u>Purpose:</u> MDE has designated ESSER funds to provide for integration of technology and technology supports, building sanitization, and personal protective equipment in support of Pre-K classrooms.

<u>Eligibility</u>: Local educational agencies that operate Pre-K classrooms that serve three- and four-year-old children (regular education, inclusive, or self-contained) are eligible for these funds.

Funding Source: Federal

Basis for Awarding the Grants: Formula Funds will be awarded based on the following methodology:

Available funds = Pre-K classroom allocation # of eligible Pre-K classrooms in state

Allocation:

Each LEA will receive an allocation based upon the number of grants that will be awarded. One hundred percent (100%) of the amount to be awarded to LEAs will be evenly distributed between classrooms of all grant recipients. The amount will be calculated as follows:

Pre-K classroom allocation x # of eligible Pre-K classrooms = LEA allocation
