05.A. <u>Action: Modify grant awards to school districts to fund Cohort II Educator-in-Residence grants for literacy coaches</u> [Goals 1, 2, and 4 – MBE Strategic Plan]

<u>Scope of Project</u>: In 2013, The Literacy-Based Promotion Act (LBPA) was established for students enrolled in Mississippi public schools to achieve grade-level reading by the end of 3rd Grade. Under the provisions of the LBPA, MDE is responsible for providing technical assistance, practitioner expertise, and capacity building across the state, in the area of literacy. The LBPA receives an annual appropriation to support effective implementation of the act.

The Office of Elementary Education and Reading, Division of Literacy, has awarded grants to participating Educator-in-Residence (EIR) districts based on successful competitive grant applications. The grant funds are distributed each year up to three annual installments based on legislative appropriations and performance evaluations with the grant ending June 30, 2023.
