- G. Approval of Renaissance and Riverside Insights for the purpose of providing qualified vendors to establish assessment instruments for local school districts and or schools

The purpose of the list is to provide districts with state-approved assessments that can be used to measure early childhood outcomes for children ages 3 - 5 in traditional, hybrid, and/or virtual school environments across the state. The assessment tool(s) will provide data in three specific areas:

- (1) Positive social-emotional skills including social relationships;
- (2) Acquisition and use of knowledge and skills including early language/communication and early literacy; and
- (3) Use of appropriate behaviors to meet their needs.

All costs of vendors will be covered by local districts and/or schools.
