Chicken Hot wings Bone-in Fully Cooked (Item #1029): Tyson (Wings of Fire) replaces the Koch hot wings for regions 3 - 7 (Merchants). Packed 70-120 wings per 10 pound case. 3 wings contribute 2 oz MMA

Regions 1 - 2 (Briggs) will continue to receive the Koch Hot Wings. Packed 80 -120 wings per 10 pound case. 3 wings contribute 2 oz MMA.



Wholesome Whole Grain Gourmet Waffle One Grain (Item# 1206): Both distributors have chosen BakeCrafters over the Peach Valley Waffle cutting the price almost in half! Each 1.3 oz. portion (cooked) will provide 1oz. Equivalent of WG's. Use for breakfast or create a sandwich. Packed 144 per case.

Reduced Fat Doritos Chips

A few months ago a fire severely damaged the Fritos plant in Arkansas that manufactures the Reduced Fat Doritos that are on the order guide. This was the only plant that produced RF Doritos in the country. A Tennessee plant has since picked up the RF Dorito production while repairs are in place at the Arkansas plant. Normal operations at the Arkansas RF plant are expected to resume in March. This means that you may see some shortages or outs on the RF Dorito products listed below. What should you do? Continue to order the chips you want. The distributors will let you know if they have shorts or outs and will make recommendations for substituting another product. The State agency will continue its communications with Frito Lay, and will update you of any changes.

The following 4 items are affected by the plant fire. Continue to order them, however realize that there may be shortages and or outs and be prepared to make a substitution from the other chips.

- 2601 - RF Tortilla Chips, Nacho Cheese WG
- 2605 - RF Tortilla Chip, Cool Ranch WG
- 2608 - RF Tortilla Chip, Flama WG
- 2612 - RF Tortilla Chip, Spicy Sweet Chili WG

These chips should not see any shortages or outs. Continue to order them and use these to substitute for shorts / outs of the RF chips above.

- 2602 - Cheetos Mellow Puffs
- 2603 - Fantastix Chili Cheese
- 2604 - Fantastix, Flamin' Hot WG

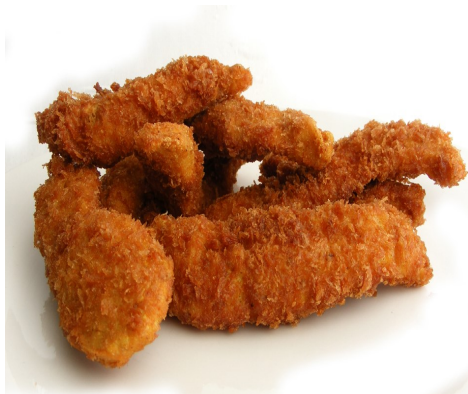
