MDE

- Manage grant operations including distribution of grant funds, program support, and recruitment and selection
- Publish grant application for Institutions of Higher-Learning and select partnering institutions
- Support residents in the teacher credentialing process

Partnering IHE

- -Serve as credit bearing institution
- Design residency experience to include coursework and classroom experience
- Provide on-going support and development for teachers in residence
- Provide guidance for clinical experience for the master teacher and resident teacher

Master Teacher

- Serve as supervising teacher
- Participate in MDE sponsored trainings
- Serve as mentor to resident teacher
- Provide resident teacher with small-group teaching experience year 1 and lead teaching experience year 2

Partnering District

- Recruit candidates to apply to the residency program
- Determine host sites for teachers in residence
- Identify and select master teachers at host site
- Participate in selection of teachers in residence
- Employ candidates at the end of residency experience

Resident Teacher

- Commit to teaching in placement district at the end of the residency experience
- Enroll in credit bearing institution as determined by the residency program
- Complete degree program and residency program requirements
- Become a certified Mississippi Teacher
