Budget Requirements

- The budget request for each school must be of sufficient size and scope to support full and effective implementation of the selected intervention over a period of up to-four years.
- The application must comply with applicable federal, state, and local requirements.

- Four Year Budget Summary
- School Detailed Budget Summary Narrative
- Federal Budget Summary

- Summary gives the amount requested for each year.
 - Note: Year 4 – The maximum amount that can be requested is 50% of what was requested in Year 1
