

Micropurchase scenarios

- Blueberry vendor John James
 - Spend \$500 for 10 pints of blueberries

ALLOWABLE?

No! Cost not reasonable.

Cloth apron vendor Smith Industries
-Spend \$200 on aprons in October
-Spend \$300 on aprons in March

ALLOWABLE?

Maybe... Other vendors available?



Micropurchase scenarios

- Clara County Schools plan to replace all lunch trays and has the funds.
 - Identify need \$4,000 worth of trays
 - Spend \$2,000 on trays on August 15
 - Spend \$2,000 on trays September 1

ALLOWABLE?

No – cannot split planned purchases

- Assorted Farmer's Market vendors
 - Budget \$1,000 for seasonal produce each quarter
 - Total spent: up to \$4,000

Have you utilized Help Desk in the past year?






If you utilized Help Desk, did you receive assistance the same day it was requested?
