

## Mississippi Academic Assessment Program (MAAP) Grade 3 LBPA Read-Aloud Accommodation Guidance

The following Read-Aloud Accommodation Guidance is now in place for the 2021-2022 assessment cycle. This document highlights the allowable read-aloud accommodations for the Grade 3 Mississippi Academic Assessment Program (MAAP) reading portion and the MAAP 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Reading Alternative Assessments. All students in grade 3, except those requiring a paper/pencil version per their IEP, 504, or LSP, must complete the writing portion of the ELA MAAP assessment online.

The following Read-Aloud Accommodation Guidance is in place for Grades 4-8 ELA and English II, Grades 3-8 Math and Algebra I, Grade 5, Grade 8, Biology, and U.S. History during the 2021-2022 assessment cycle. All students in grades 4-8 and English II, except those requiring a paper/pencil version per their IEP, 504, or LSP, must complete the writing portion of the ELA MAAP assessment online.
