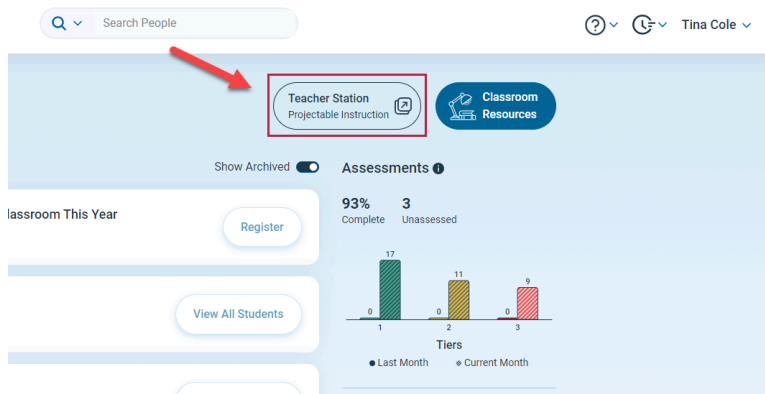


# ISIP Assessment Script

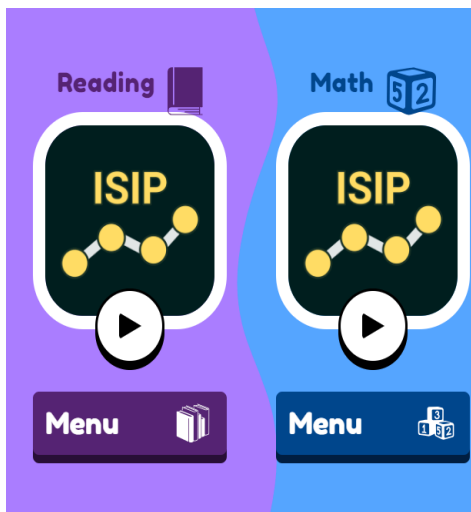
PreK and Kindergarten students preparing to take the ISIP

## Introduce the Tutorial/Modeling:

Log into Istation on your computer.  
Click on Teacher Station.



"Good morning, boys and girls! Today, we have something exciting planned. We're going to practice letters and sounds (or numbers and shapes) in Istation. You will use Istation this year to learn letters, sounds, numbers, and other things."



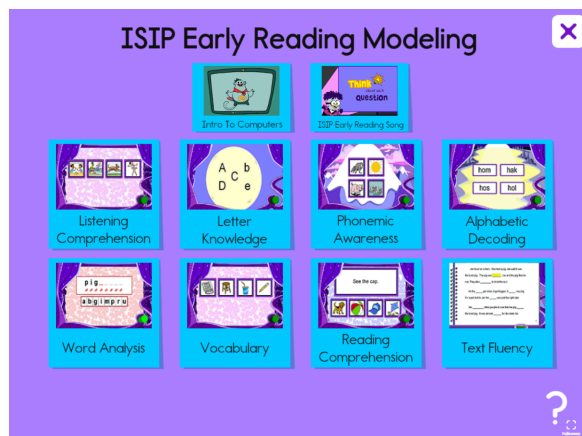
Click on the ISIP Reading or Math play button.

“The narrator tells us to click on the green GO button. But we need to practice first.”

“I am going to the top right corner where I see this button with the letter i inside a circle. Raise your hand if you see the letter i with the circle around it.”

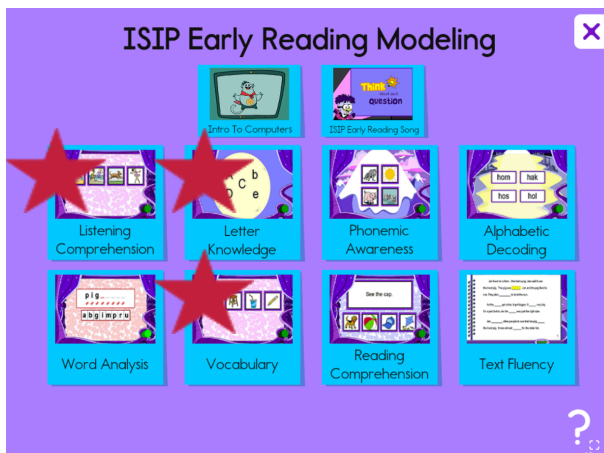


“Let’s click on the letter i button.”

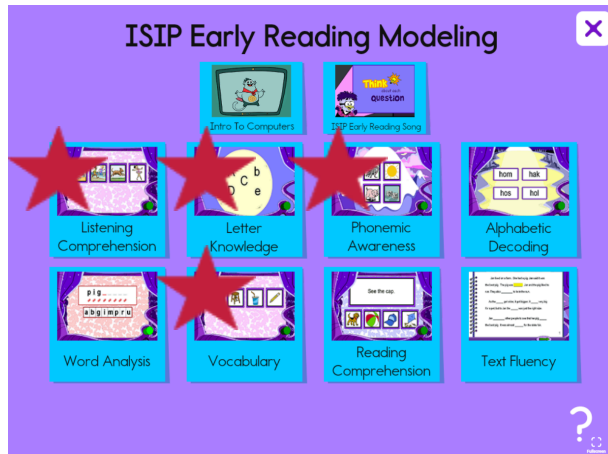


“We can do many things on this page, but we only need to do a few of these activities.”

For **PreK** Reading, let students each have an opportunity to interact with the **Listening Comprehension, Letters, and Vocabulary subtests.**



For **Kindergarten** Reading, let students each have an opportunity to interact with the **Listening Comprehension, Letters, Phonemic Awareness, and Vocabulary** subtests.



On another day, go to the Math ISIP tutorial and let students take turns interacting with Mario's Market walkthrough.



After you exit the tutorial, say, “We are not ready to click the green GO button yet. We still need to practice. Let’s go to the top left corner and click the black “back” button and then click the white “log out” button.
