I. Case of Haley Perry, Educator license No. 319259

Jonathan Dennis, legal advisor to the Commission Hearing Subcommittee, called the hearing to order at 9:06 a.m.

After all exhibits were received into evidence and testimony heard, Jamie Creel made a motion to go into closed session. Kim Hubbard seconded the motion and the Commission Hearing Subcommittee unanimously voted to go into closed session. Jamie Creel made a motion to go into executive session for the purpose of deliberations and findings concerning the Educator license at issue in the present case. Kim Hubbard seconded the motion and the Commission Hearing Subcommittee unanimously voted to go into executive session. 
