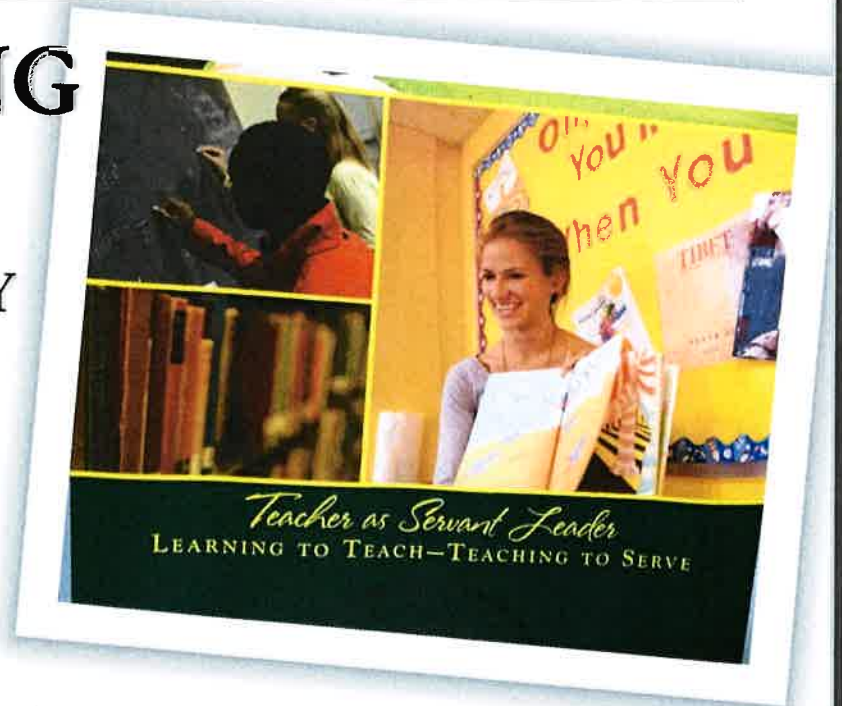

BELHAVEN UNIVERSITY IS OFFERING A \$5,000 YEARLY SCHOLARSHIP FOR 4 YEARS

Belhaven University offers a **Four Year Annual \$5,000 Academic Scholarship** totaling \$20,000 to all qualifying high school students who have graduated from a Mississippi State Teacher Academy program and who have been admitted into Belhaven University as a declared Elementary Education or Music Education major. This award will be given in addition to the merit-based scholarship received upon admission to Belhaven. This financial aid is applied to the student's account once a year over a period of four consecutive years during the Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, and Senior years while enrolled as a Teacher Education major in the School of Education or the Teacher Education Music degree program.

ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES ARE REQUIRED TO MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Have met all requirements to be admitted to Belhaven University
- Have an ACT composite score of 21 or higher
- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 from courses taken during their Teacher Academy program
- When enrolling in Belhaven University, qualifying students will be required to declare to be an Elementary Education or a Music Education major
- While enrolled in the University the teacher candidate will be required to maintain a 2.75 or higher overall GPA each semester in order to receive the financial Teacher Academy scholarship.
- Once admitted, should a candidate change his/her degree major from Education or Music Education, the Teacher Academy scholarship will no longer be valid and will no longer be applied to that student's account.

SCHOOL OF EDUCATION IS OFFERING CREDIT FOR TWO –THREE CREDIT HOUR COURSES

Students at the high school level involved in Teacher Academies throughout the state take courses that are equivalent to beginning foundational courses offered in Colleges and Schools of Education within the State. The Belhaven University School of Education will award Teacher Academy students up to six (6) credit hours, for two (2) courses within the School of Education as credit towards a degree in Elementary Education or Music Education. Student applicants desiring credit for their high school Teacher Academic courses will be required to enter Belhaven University as a declared Elementary or Music Education major and have no less than a letter grade of **B** in each of the two Teacher Academy high school courses in order to apply college credit towards an Education degree. Students will also be required to have a 21 or higher on their ACT college entrance exam prior to admission to Belhaven University under this School of Education program offer.

The two Education courses identified by the Belhaven School of Education awarded for credit to students for their involvement in a Mississippi Teacher Academy are:*

- **EDU 200 – INTRODUCTION TO EDUCATION**
- **EDU 221 – CHILD DEVELOPMENT**

ELIGIBILITY FOR TEACHER ACADEMY COURSE CREDIT REQUIREMENTS

Students desiring credit for their high school Teacher Academic courses will be required to:

- enter Belhaven University as a declared Elementary or Music Teacher Education major
- have no less than a letter grade of B in each of the two Teacher Academy high school courses to be applied towards college credit as part of the Education degree.
- have a 21 or higher on their ACT college entrance exam prior to admission to Belhaven University.

Up to 6 credit hours or 2 predetermined courses may be accepted into the Belhaven University School of Education Teacher Preparation program at the Bachelor Degree level from an approved Mississippi Teacher Academy.
