



Unit 4: The World of Color

In Unit 4, children explore the world of color and the colors in their world. They learn about the functionality of color: color communicates information and ideas, and is an identifying feature in art and nature. Children refine their experience with color mixing to include tinting and shading. They learn about permanent and temporary colors, staining and fading, and they dramatize washing and drying by creating a Laundromat. Children learn that color names can be inspired by objects, emotions, and experiences.

Children explore the concepts of same and different, the richness of diversity, and the aesthetic appeal of color. They learn how colors, feelings, attitudes, and perspectives can transform.
