Flipgrid is a video discussion platform that enables educators to see and hear from every student in the class and foster an engaging and supportive social learning environment. Flipgrid allows the educator to prompt students via video and/or allow students to answer prompts with a creative video of their own.

CLASSROOM CONNECTIONS

[4Cs: Collaboration, Communication, Creativity, Critical Thinking]

Flipgrid is a video tool that allows educators to post videos that allow online discussion with students or with other educators. This video and text can be shared with students who can then respond via video. Teachers can create groups, discover premade Flipgrid topics, or combine videos into a collection titled "mixtapes".

Communication Teachers can post questions and/or videos and allow students to respond with text or videos. Teachers can set videos or responses as public which allows for not only teacher feedback but also peer feedback. Flipgrid allows students to record thoughts or ideas that have been difficult to put on paper.

Creativity Students can create, trim, arrange, and edit video clips.

TRY IT

When working on a chapter or unit have your students verbally record a video describing the meaning of important key terms. Students can also choose to create a picture or object that illustrates the meaning of the word.
