



Loom is a screen recording tool that lets users record audio, video, browser windows, or entire screens using a Chrome extension, desktop app, or mobile app. Loom allows educators to easily share a screen recording to their LMS. A free educator account is available by signing up with your school email address at loom.com/education.

[4Cs: Collaboration, Communication, Creativity, Critical Thinking]

Use Loom to enable individualized instruction, complement curriculum, create a flipped classroom, give feedback, and give directions to prepare students to do their best work. Loom can also be used to record instructions and assignments missed by students who were absent.

Communication Create a video to give student feedback on assignments.

Collaboration Create screencasts on various topics and assign to groups of students for discussion.
