RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Family Engagement/Transition Coach (FE/T) will use the family engagement plan to support school districts and early childhood service providers to provide on-going technical assistance to administrators and teachers with a menu of services to increase family engagement activities in the North Mississippi area that may include the following counties: Tunica, Desoto, Marshal Benton, Tippah, Alcorn, Tishomingo, Coahoma, Quitman, Panola, Tate, Lafayette, Union, Prentiss, Itawamba, Bolivar, Sunflower, Tallahatchie, Yalobusha, Calhoun, Chickasaw, Monroe, Leflore, Grenada, Carroll, Montgomery, Webster, Clay, Oktibbeha, Lowndes, Lee, Pontotoc, and Choctaw. The FE/T Coach will be responsible for the teaching and coaching to ensure schools address family engagement practices on their campuses. The FE/T Coach will be responsible for carrying out large and small group training opportunities across the state on topics related to family engagement. The incumbent will be trained and become reliable in CLASS.
