01. <u>Action: Renew contract with Voyager Sopris Learning, Inc. for the operation of</u> <u>the Mississippi K-3 Literacy Professional Development Training System</u> [Goal 1 -MBE Strategic Plan]

<u>Scope of Project</u>: The Literacy-Based Promotion Act was established for students enrolled in Mississippi public schools to achieve grade-level reading by the end of 3rd grade. The Mississippi Department of Education is responsible for providing technical assistance and training for teachers and administrators as may be needed to aid local school districts in administering the provisions of the legislation.

The K-3 literacy training procured for the second year of a five-year contract will build content and pedagogical knowledge of the essential elements of literacy and provide strategies for supporting effective reading instruction.

Renewal of contract for years three through five will be determined annually and shall be contingent upon the successful completion of the preceding year's contract and the availability of funds. Personnel associated with this contract are not former Department employees or related to any Department employees.
