F. Revise the methodology to reallocate relinquished Homeless Education grant dollars in accordance with the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act

<u>Purpose</u>: For the purpose of reallocation, any Homeless Education funds relinquished by a grantee or not expended within the established funding period shall be redistributed the following year based on the approved methodology. Reallocated funds will be used by to Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) to ensure that homeless children, including preschoolers and youth, receive services to eliminate barriers to their education by providing supplemental instruction, transportation, free school meals, enriched educational services, social services, and medical services.

<u>Eligibility</u>: All sub-grantees receiving grant funds during the reallocation period are eligible.

Funding Source: Title IX, Part A of the Every Student Succeeds Act

<u>Basis for Awarding the Reallocation</u>: The reallocation will be based on the number of grants to be awarded.

Funds will be reallocated based on the following methodology:

I. Base Reallocation:

If funds are relinquished by a grantee or not expended within the previously established funding period, each grant recipient will receive a base reallocation based upon the number of grants that will be awarded. Fifty percent (50%) of the LEA reservation will be evenly distributed among all grant recipients. The base allocation will be calculated as follows:

50% of the total LEA Reallocation Amount to be Awarded = Base Reallocation Total # grant recipients

II. Additional Reallocation:

The funds available after the base reallocations are awarded will be reallocated to all grant recipients on a per pupil basis.

The per pupil amount will be calculated as follows:

Total funds available after LEA base reallocations

Total # homeless students enrolled in the districts that are grant recipients

= Per pupil amount

The additional reallocation will be calculated as follows:

Per pupil amount x # homeless students enrolled = Amount of additional reallocation

Purpose: For the purpose of reallocation, any Homeless Education funds relinquished by a grantee or not expended within the established funding period shall be redistributed the following year based on the approved methodology. For Reallocated funds will be used by to Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) to ensure that homeless children, including preschoolers and youth, receive a free and appropriate public education services to eliminate barriers to their education by and enable their success by eliminating barriers through providing supplemental instruction, transportation, free school meals, enriched educational services, social services, and medical services. For the purpose of reallocation, any funds relinquished by a grantee or not expended within the established funding period shall be redistributed the following year based on the approved methodology.

<u>Eligibility</u>: All sub-grantees receiving grant funds during the reallocation period are eligible.

Funding Source: Federal Section 723 requires states to allocate no less than 75% of the amount reserved for McKinney-Vento Education for Homeless Children and Youth Program to LEAs. Title IX, Part A of the Every Student Succeeds Act

Basis for Awarding the ReallocationGrants: Competitive The reallocation will be based on the number of grants to be awarded.

Funds will be awarded-reallocated based on the following methodology:

Base Reallocation:

If funds are relinquished by a grantee or not expended within the previously established funding period, Eeach LEA grant recipient will receive a base reallocation based upon the number of grants that will be awarded. Fifty

percent (50%) of the <u>LEA reservation</u>amount to be awarded to <u>LEAs</u> will be evenly distributed among all grant recipients. The base <u>amountallocation</u> will be calculated as follows:

50% of the total LEA Repallocation Amount to be Aawarded = Base reallocation ______ Total # grant recipients

II. Additional Reallocation:

The funds available after the base reallocations are awarded (50% of the amount to be awarded) will be reallocated to all grant recipients on a per pupil basis.

The per pupil amount will be calculated as follows:

Total funds available after LEA base reallocations

(50% of awarded

Total #

homeless students enrolled in the districts that are grant recipients

= Per pupil amount

The additional reallocation will be calculated as follows:

Per pupil amount x # homeless students enrolled = Amount of additional reallocation

The methodology will be reviewed annually to determine if revisions are necessary as a result of changes in funding or changes in the law. Revisions to the methodology will be presented for Board approval.
