04. <u>Information: Spring 2017 Mississippi Academic Assessment Program (MAAP) results</u> [Goals 1 and 2 – MBE Strategic Plan]

<u>Background Information</u>: The Mississippi Academic Assessment Program (MAAP) is aligned to the 2014 Mississippi College and Career Readiness (CCR) Standards. Students began taking the MAAP in English Language Arts and Math in grades 3-8, English II and Algebra I in 2015-2016.

On July 25, 2016, the Mississippi State Board of Education (SBE) approved the cut scores for the MAAP. MAAP measures student progress in grades 3 through 8 with annual tests in English Language Arts and Mathematics and in high school Algebra I and English II. MAAP contains five (5) achievement levels: Minimal, Basic, Passing, Proficient and Advanced.
