<u>Scope of Project</u>: The purpose of this contract is to retain the services of the Mississippi State Department of Health to conduct pre-operational and operational inspections of Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) feeding sites throughout the state of Mississippi.

The Office of Child Nutrition will provide contractor with a list of SFSP sites throughout the state. Contractor will prioritize the inspections as instructed by the Office of Child Nutrition (e.g. sites that are new to the program will be inspected before returning sites). A total of 754 site visits per fiscal year may be conducted. The contractor will bill the Office of Child Nutrition only for the actual number of inspections conducted and will provide proof of each inspection conducted and the results therof prior to payment.

Renewal of contract for years 2 through 4 will be determined annually and shall be contingent upon the successful completion of the preceding year's contract and the availability of funds. Personnel associated with this contract are not former Department employees or related to any Department employees.

Scope of Contract:

• Term of Contract: July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019 (with three one-year renewals)

Total Amount to be Awarded: \$94,250

Method of Award: Exempt from Competitive Requirements

<u>Funding Source</u>: Federal (USDA State Administrative Expense)

Summary of Selection Process:

The Mississippi State Department of Health is the only entity qualified to perform the work contemplated by this contract (public health inspections). The USDA provides funding to MDE specifically for these inspections.
