## Minutes of Mississippi Board of Education Meeting

### May 16, 2024

The members of the Mississippi Board of Education met at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 16, 2024, pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 25-41-5 for the purpose of conducting a regularly scheduled Board meeting.

The public accessed this meeting via livestream or in-person at the Central High School Building, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor Boardroom, 359 North West Street, Jackson, Mississippi. Board members physically present included: Mr. Glen V. East, Mr. Bill Jacobs, Mr. Matt Mayo, Dr. Ronnie L. McGehee, Mr. Matt Miller, and Mr. Mike Pruitt. Board member participating virtually: Dr. Wendi Barrett (Ocean Springs, Mississippi). Board members absent: Ms. Mary Werner and Ms. Billye Jean Stroud. Student Representative absent: Ms. Kate Riddle. Dr. Raymond C. Morgigno, Interim State Superintendent, was also present.

- Mr. Glen V. East called the Board meeting to order at 10:00 a.m., after determining that a quorum of the Board existed for the purpose of conducting a meeting.
- II. Dr. Ronnie L. McGehee led the Pledge of Allegiance and Mr. Matt Miller gave the Invocation.
- III. On a motion by Mr. Bill Jacobs, seconded by Dr. Ronnie L. McGehee, the Board unanimously approved the minutes of April 18, 2024 Board meeting and minutes of Special-Called Teleconference Board meeting on May 1, 2024.

- VI. Dr. Raymond C. Morgigno gave the following report as the Interim State Superintendent of Education:
  - Dr. Morgigno stated he attended the Accountability Task Force meeting.
  - Dr. Morgigno stated the six Regional Superintendent meetings were held across the state and Mr. Matt Miller joined the meeting in Hattiesburg.

- Dr. Morgigno stated the Teacher Advisory Council meetings were held in Oxford, Clinton, and Gulfport. Dr. Morgigno stated that some of the final research projects from the Student Advisory Council members were shared with the teachers.
- Pr. Morgigno stated he spoke at the 2024 Mississippi Administrator of the Year and the Teacher of the Year Celebration. Dr. Morgigno stated the Administrator of the Year is Anita Wansley, Principal at Northeast Elementary School in the Lauderdale County School District and the Teacher of the Year is Shauna Waters, teacher at West Lauderdale High School in the Lauderdale County School District. Dr. Morgigno congratulated both and thanked the MDE team that put this celebration together.
- Dr. Morgigno stated he spoke at the Gulfport Rotary Club, and he stated that Mr. Glen V. East attended the meeting.

- IX. Report on State Board of Education Subcommittee meeting

Mr. Bill Jacobs, Chair, Internal Accountability Subcommittee, stated that on May 1 and 2, 2024 the subcommittee interviewed the 10 semifinalists and chose the top three highest scoring finalists to be interviewed by the Board on June 19, 2024, starting at 8:30 a.m. Mr. Jacobs stated the three finalists are: Crosby Parker, Gulfport School District, Gulfport High School; Annsley Coleman, New Albany School District, New Albany High School; and Zenaida Caquias, Gulfport School District, Gulfport High School. Mr Jacobs stated the Board will select a junior student representative and an alternate after the interviews and the student representative will begin their term on July 1, 2024 and end on April 30, 2026. Mr. Jacobs stated that all the students that applied for the Junior Student Representative will be added to the Student Advisory Council.

#### XI. Consideration of Executive Session

Mr. Matt Miller moved that the Board consider making a closed determination of the need to go into Executive Session. Mr. Matt Mayo seconded the motion, and the motion passed by unanimous vote. Mr. Glen V. East asked for Ms. Lindsay Dowdle, AG Counsel, and legal counsel to remain in the room.

Mr. Matt Miller, then moved that the Board go into Executive Session in accordance with Miss. Code Ann. § 25-41-7 (4)(a) and (k) for discussion of discrete personnel matters and Miss. Code Ann. § 25-41-7 (4)(b) for strategy sessions or negotiations with respect to prospective litigation, ongoing litigation, or issuance of an appealable order. Dr. Ronnie L. McGehee seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote. Ms. Jennifer Nichols informed the public of the Board's vote to go into Executive Session for the above stated reasons.

#### **Minutes of the Executive Session**

During the Executive Session, the Board discussed discrete personnel matters and strategy sessions or negotiations with respect to prospective litigation, ongoing litigation, or issuance of an appealable order.

On a motion by Mr. Matt Miller, seconded by Mr. Matt Mayo, the Board unanimously voted to come out of Executive Session.

The public came back into the Board meeting and Mr. East stated that the Board approved the appointment of Mr. LaMarlon Wilson as the Superintendent of the Mississippi Schools for the Deaf and the Blind.

- 02. On a motion by Mr. Matt Miller, seconded by Mr. Bill Jacobs, the Board voted unanimously to appoint Ms. Erin Meyer or Mr. Matt Miller to serve as a representative on behalf of the MDE for purposes of litigation against the Mississippi Schools for the Deaf and the Blind (MSDB).
- 03. On a motion by Mr. Bill Jacobs, seconded by Mr. Mike Pruitt, the Board voted unanimously to appoint Mr. Michael D. Kent as a hearing officer for a certified employee's termination hearing.
- 04. On a motion by Mr. Matt Miller, seconded by Dr. Ronnie L. McGehee, the Board voted unanimously to approve the appointment of Mr. LaMarlon Wilson to serve as the Superintendent for the Mississippi Schools for the Deaf and the Blind at an annual salary of \$115,000.00.

#### XII. State Board of Education

1. Mr. Matt Miller stated he attended the Regional Superintendents meeting in Hattiesburg where MDE department heads presented, and he thought it was

important for the superintendents to see the staff and hear the updates from them. Mr. Miller stated that he attended his first meeting virtually of the Government Affairs Committee for the National Association of State Boards of Education (NASBE) last week about CTE and it was interesting. Mr. Miller stated that Mississippi is ahead of several states with the strides CTE is making.

- Mr. East asked for a motion for Ms. Billye Jean Stroud to attend the NASBE New Member Orientation Institute in Washington, DC on July 9-10, 2024.
   On a motion from Mr. Matt Mayo, seconded by Mr. Matt Miller, the Board unanimously approved for Ms. Billye Jean Stroud to attend the NASBE meeting.
- 3. On a motion by Mr. Bill Jacobs, seconded by Mr. Mike Pruitt, the Board unanimously approved the meeting dates for Fiscal Year 2025.

#### XIII. Other Business

Mr. Glen V. East stated the State Board will have a work session for the Finalist Interviews for Junior Representative and the Fiscal Budget meeting on June 19, 2024 in Jackson, MS at the Central High School Building starting at 8:30 a.m. Mr. East stated that Mr. Matt Miller will be serving as Acting Chair in his absence.

Mr. East stated the June Board meeting will be held on June 20, 2024, in Jackson, MS at the Central High School Building in the 4<sup>th</sup> Floor Boardroom starting at 10:00 a.m.
