04. <u>Action: Approval to modify certain licensure assessment guidelines for Instructional Support and Administrator Licensure Endorsement Areas</u> [Goal 4 – MBE Strategic Plan]

(Has cleared the Administrative Procedures Act process without public comments)

<u>Background Information</u>: On November 2, 2018, the Commission on Teacher and Administrator Education and Licensure and Development granted approval to modify certain licensure assessment guidelines for Instructional Support and Administrator Licensure Endorsement Areas. Miss. Code Ann. § 37-3-2 (5)(f) charges the Licensure Commission with reviewing all existing requirements for certification and licensure. Further, Miss. Code Ann. § 37-3-2 (5)(e) mandates more specifically, the review and evaluation of objective measures of teacher performance, such as test scores, which may form part of the licensure process, and to make recommendations for their use.

In accordance with the responsibilities outlined in State Law, the Division of Educator Licensure engages in continuous review of all Educator and Administrator Licensure Guidelines and other related policies, processes, and procedures to ensure that all remain relevant, necessary, and reflect current State and Federal Statutes and State Board policies as appropriate.

According to current guidelines, each prospective educator admitted to a <u>teacher</u> education preparation program in Mississippi shall attain the minimum qualifying score as required by the State Board for the Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators (Praxis Core) assessments of reading, writing, and mathematics or provide documentation of evidence of having achieved a composite score of twenty-one (21) on the ACT or an equivalent score on the SAT assessments to be accepted in lieu of the Praxis Core requirement.

<u>Instructional Support and Administrator</u> licensure endorsement areas are not considered teaching fields. In keeping with current guidelines and to ensure that criteria for obtaining a Mississippi license in the endorsement areas noted herein, the Division of Educator Licensure is recommending the removal of the requirement of Praxis Core, or ACT, or SAT assessments as one criterion in the multi-step process for receiving a license in an Instructional Support or

Administrator endorsement area. In addition, the Division is recommending the removal of the Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) assessment as one criterion for obtaining certain Instructional Support or Administrator licenses to ensure consistency across all pathways. Additionally, all but one of the endorsement areas are issued at the Class AA (Master's Degree) license level or higher at which point candidates would have already proven mastery of basic knowledge and skills.

The public comment period was open through 5:00 p.m. on January 31, 2019 and no public comments were received.
