B. Approval of methodology to award grants to local school districts to support the State Systemic Improvement Plan literacy coaches under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act

<u>Background and Purpose</u>: The Office of Special Education has developed a State Systemic Improvement Plan (SSIP) that is designed to build the capacity of local school districts in the use of evidence-based practices in reading with a focus on improving third grade reading proficiency outcomes. The purpose of grants is to provide funding for half the salary plus benefits, up to \$35,000, for literacy coaches in local school districts identified as SSIP districts.

<u>Eligibility</u>: Only school districts identified as SSIP districts with an acceptable application are eligible to receive grant funds.

<u>Funding Source</u>: Federal funds

Basis for Awarding the Grants: Discretionary to all districts identified as SSIP.

Grant amounts will not exceed \$35,000 per district awarded to SSIP district that hire a literacy coach.
