

U.S. Presidential Scholars Recognition Program- 2025

The U. S. Presidential Scholars Program (USPSP) was established in 1964 by Executive Order of the President to recognize distinguished high school seniors for their accomplishments in academics, the arts, and career and technical education fields.

This year, Dr. Lance Evans, State Superintendent of Education, will nominate up to 20 students (10 males and 10 females) for the general component of the program and up to five (5) students for the CTE component.
