I. Case of Khrysten Glass, Educator License No. 307490

Jonathan Dennis, legal advisor to the Commission Hearing Subcommittee, called the hearing to order at 9:28 a.m.

William Murphy seconded the motion, and the Commission Hearing Subcommittee unanimously voted to suspend Respondent's educator license for one (1) year.


In open session, counsel read the decision of the Commission Hearing Subcommittee to the participants.
