RESPONSIBILITIES:

This position serves at the Director of Student Outcomes within the Bureau of Policy and Practice in the Office of Special Education plays a critical leadership role in ensuring equitable and positive outcomes for students with disabilities. This position is responsible for collaborating across divisions, analyzing data trends, supporting continuous improvement efforts, and promoting evidence-based practices that drive academic, behavioral, and post-secondary success for students with disabilities. This position analyzes student outcome data (e.g., graduation rates, assessment performance, post-secondary readiness, discipline data, and disproportionality) to identify trends and areas for targeted supports. The Director of Student Outcomes leads the development and dissemination of professional learning and technical assistance related to student outcomes for stakeholders. Moderate travel is required.

SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor's degree required; higher levels of education preferred. A minimum of 1-2 years in the field of special education is required. Experience with data collection, analysis, and professional learning is preferred. Excellent oral and written communication skills is required.
