- Participates in virtual and in-person technical assistance activities with national technical assistance centers, communities of practice, and internal program offices.
- Assists with fiscal monitoring activities.
- Assists with the review and development related policies and procedures.
- Monitors schedules and track deadlines for various programs, grants, site visits and technical assistance activities.
- Assists with Internal Fiscal Operations.
