RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Knowledge of state statutes and State Board regulations related to the Mississippi Statewide Assessment System.
- Review state assessment systems and documentation to ensure alignment with the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) peer review requirements.
- Prepare and organize documentation for ESEA peer review materials, correspondence, and feedback from the U.S. Department of Education (ED).
- Review assessment items, passages, and stimuli to ensure they accurately measure the intended content standards and objectives.
- Evaluate assessment items for clarity, grammar, punctuation, and consistency of format and syle. Check that all graphics, tables, and figures are accurate, clear, and relevant to the item's intent
- Ensure test items align with test blueprints, content frameworks, and assessment specifications.
- Collaborate with internal review teams including the Technical Advisory Committee.
- Assist with the review and construction of RFP, RFQ, and RFA submissions.

EXPERIENCE/EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Typically requires a Master's Degree, 5+ years of experience.
- A Doctorate Degree (Preferred) from an accredited four-year college or university.
- Five Plus (5+) years in the special experience defined below, four (4) years of which must have included line or functional administrative or advanced technical supervision.
- Employment must have been in an area of work related to the functional responsibility of the position.

SPECIAL EXPERIENCE:

- Experience with and knowledge of the ESEA peer review process.
- Experience with the review and direction of large-scale assessment systems.
