RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Mississippi Department of Education is seeking an individual to serve the role of Education Program Development Team Lead in the Office of Career and Technical Education (CTE) as a CTE program supervisor for Construction and Advanced Manufacturing. Incumbents are responsible for working with secondary CTE teachers and the State CTE leadership to provide leadership and guidance related to the growth and promotion of secondary CTE programs in Mississippi. The ideal candidate must be dependable, detail-oriented, self-driven, and a team player with the ability to communicate in writing and verbally and manage multiple priorities within established timelines. Knowledge and experience with construction and/or manufacturing and the Mississippi Department of Education's secondary construction and advanced manufacturing is required.

Examples of work performed in this classification include, but are not limited to the following:

- Directs construction practice related to secondary career and technical education construction programs.
- Conducts research and design curriculum and assessments related to secondary construction and advanced manufacturing programs such as carpentry, electrical, metal fabrication, and advanced manufacturing.
- Providing individual and statewide CTE training modules.
- Assist trade workers in transitioning to career and technical education classrooms.
- Collaborate with others to achieve organizational goals.
- Provides a teaching atmosphere conducive to the learning of new concepts and skills.
- Performs related or similar duties as required or assigned.

EXPERIENCE/EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS:

Typically requires a relevant Master's Degree, may require certification, and 4+ years of experience.
