02. Information: Spring 2025 ACT Results [Goals 1 and 2 – MBE Strategic Plan]

Background Information:

The ACT was administered to all juniors in the state of Mississippi during the spring semester of 2025. The report includes:

- Summary of statewide results in comparison to 2024
- Summary of students meeting College Readiness Benchmark Scores in comparison to 2024

College Readiness Benchmark Scores – A benchmark score is the minimum score needed on an ACT subject area test to indicate a 50% chance of obtaining a B or higher or approximately a 75% chance of obtaining a C or higher in the corresponding credit bearing college courses, which include English Composition, Algebra, Social Science and Biology. These scores were empirically derived based on the actual performance of students in college. The College Readiness Benchmark Scores, updated in August of 2013, are:
