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2025 Executive Summary

What is the Mississippi Academic Assessment Program (MAAP)?

- The Mississippi Academic Assessment Program (MAAP) measures students' knowledge, skills, and academic growth from elementary through high school.
- Student progress is measured from annual assessments in Grades 3 through 8 Mathematics and English Language Arts (ELA), Grades 5 and 8 Science, and in End-of-Course (EOC) assessments in Algebra I, English II, Biology, and U.S. History.
- MAAP assessments are designed to inform parents about how their child is progressing and to provide teachers with information to guide instruction.




- MAAP was administered online for all students.
- Students with disabilities and English learners were afforded testing accommodations including paper-pencil forms if needed.
- The 2025 assessment results include all students tested during the 2024-2025 school year.
- Assessment results for End-of-Course (EOC) re-testers are not included in this report.
- MAAP results are reported in two ways for Mathematics, ELA, Science, and U.S. History. Each student receives a scale score and a performance level between 1 and 5 (1-Minimal, 2-Basic, 3-Pass, 4-Proficient, or 5-Advanced).

MAAP Results

- Mississippi students maintain their progress from 2022 to show successive rebounds in all proficiency rates from the pre-pandemic to current.
- Overall, all four subject areas showed a slight drop in proficiency as compared to 2023-2024.
- For 2024-2025, the percentage of students scoring proficient or advanced was 54.5% in mathematics, 47.4% in ELA, 60.9% in science, and 69.7% in U. S. History.
- Total students tested excludes invalidated assessments.


State Level MAAP Results: Overall Mathematics




State Level MAAP Results: Overall English Language Arts (ELA)









State Level Proficiency Comparisons from 2023-2024 to 2024-2025

Mathematics

- Mathematics showed no change in proficiency for grade 3 and increases in proficiency for grade 4 and grade 6 as compared to 2024.
- Mathematics Grade 4 had the highest increase in proficiency from 55.0% in 2024 to 56.6% in 2025.

English Language Arts (ELA)

- ELA showed proficiency increases in grade 5, grade 6, and English II as compared to 2024.
- ELA Grade 6 had the highest increase in proficiency from 39.7% in 2024 to 46.7% in 2025.

Science

- Science showed a proficiency increase in biology as compared to 2024.
- Biology increased from 60.5% in 2024 to 62.0% in 2025.

- Beginning with the 2025-2026 school year, the U.S. History assessment will no longer be used as a graduation requirement and has been removed from the MAAP program.
