
Scale Score Explanation and Kindergarten Readiness Performance Levels

The Kindergarten Readiness Assessment (KRA) provides parents, teachers, and early childhood educators with a common understanding of what children know and are able to do entering school. The primary purpose of the KRA is to improve the quality of classroom instruction and other services provided to students from birth to 3rd grade.

Background and Cut Score Explanation

From 2014-2024, Renaissance Learning provided the Kindergarten Readiness. The cut score was set in 2014 to align with 3rd grade reading expectations and never increased. In the 2018-2019 school year, the 3rd grade reading expectations were increased to a level 3, 4, or 5. In 2024, a new vendor, Imagination Station, was procured. *Istation's Indicators of Progress (ISIP™)* developed by Imagination Station is a computer-adaptive assessment that adjusts questions based on student responses to determine different areas of strengths and opportunities for growth. During the process of setting the new vendor's cut score, the MDE and our Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) determined that the rigor of the cut score needed to be increased to align with the expectations of the 3rd grade reading assessment. It was determined Istation's BOY 61st percentile linked very closely to the past Kindergarten BOY cut. The TAC and MDE determined all cuts would be set at the 61st percentile falling in the Level 4 or "Ready" category for all cut scores. A spring scale score of 284 places students on a trajectory to exceed end of 3rd grade reading expectations. **These scores are not comparable to past year's scores.** Some school's scores may be lower due to "gating" and the lack of using the available progress monitoring resource. Gating requires multiple demonstrations of a qualifying score to access more difficult content. When schools do not use the available progress-monitoring resource frequently, this effect is magnified. Fewer testing opportunities mean fewer chances for students to meet the gating requirements, so they spend more time on easier content. This can "artificially" hold down scores because students' abilities may be higher than the level they are being tested on. Consequently, some schools-especially those that test infrequently-may not show gains that would be expected based on classroom performance.
