  - Business
  - Education
  - Health Science and Nursing
  - Hospitality and Human Services
  - Public Safety and Administration
  - Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics

- In the 2021-2022 school-year, all DC CTE individual MSIS codes were deleted except for CTE Smart Start (substitution for the CCR course)
- CTE dual credit (DC) courses will be coded based on one of the 16 national career clusters
- If a student is a DC completer, the DC CTE Pathway Completer code should be utilized
- The 16 clusters will be reduced to 14 clusters for 2026-2027 new codes will be developed




- Districts may duplicate the CTE DC Pathway Codes if the local code and section numbers are different (see next slide)
- Districts should enter the exact community college course name within the SMS
- Example:
  - 1. MSIS Code: 997414 Dual Credit Education and Training
  - 2. Enter the exact name of the college course including prefix and number into the SMS: CDT1113 Early Childhood Profession
  - 3. Do not use the high school CTE course name such as Early Childhood I
