Mississippi Academic Assessment Program (MAAP) Accommodation 20 Extended Time and Accommodation 25 Multi-Day Stopping Points Guidance

Extended Time (20)

Extended Time (20) is defined as a specified amount of extra time which cannot extend beyond the end of the instructional day. The extended time accommodation (20) is different from the multi-day accommodation (25). A student may have both the extended time accommodation (20) and the multiday accommodation (25), but this must be listed in their Individualized Education Plan (IEP), Section 504 Plan, or Language Services Plan (LSP) and specified for the respective assessment(s).

Multi-Day Testing (25)

Multi-Day Testing (25) is defined as administer the test over consecutive days, specifying the number of days (i.e., two or three days) of each session. Testing must be completed within testing window. Below are the Office of Student Assessment (OSA) mandated stops for online and paper testers who have Accommodation 25 included on their IEP/Section 504 Plan/LSP and specified for this assessment. All testers with this accommodation must stop at the designated items each day. Students with a 2-day accommodation will stop at the appropriate item listed below on day 1 and complete the remaining items on day 2. Students with the 3- day accommodation will stop at the appropriate item listed below and complete all remaining items on day 3.
