



Extra Time (A20)

Accommodation (A20) is defined as Extra Time where the amount of extra time must be specified. Extra Time (A20) cannot extend beyond the end of the instructional day. Note that Extra Time (A20) accommodation is different from the Multi-Day (A25) accommodation. A student may have both the Extra Time (A20) accommodation and the Multi-Day (A25) accommodation, but this must be listed in their Individualized Education Plan (IEP), Section 504 Plan, or Language Services Plan (LSP) and specified in detail for the respective assessment(s).

Multi-Day Testing (A25)

Accommodation (A25) is defined as Multi-Day Testing where the test is administered over consecutive days, with a specified number of days (i.e., two or three days). Testing must be completed within the testing window. Below are the Office of Student Assessment (OSA) mandated stops for online and paper testers who have Accommodation (A25) included on their IEP/Section 504 Plan/LSP and specified for an assessment. All testers with this accommodation must stop at the designated items each day. Students with a 2-day accommodation will stop at the **appropriate item listed below** on day 1 and complete the remaining items on day 2. Students with the 3- day accommodation will stop at the **appropriate item listed below** and complete all remaining items on day 3.

ELA Writing Multi-Day Testing and Extra Time

The writing prompts can be given on separate days as well. Students can have a 2-day accommodation for writing. Students with this accommodation, will take prompt 1 on day 1 and will complete prompt 2 on day 2. The system will not allow the student to go back and review the work from the previous day. These are considered separate days from session one (1) of the assessment and are also shown in the chart above. If full instructional day is provided for extra time in addition to multi-day testing, then each testing day the student will be provided the full instructional day to finish the prompt. If a specific number of extra minutes or extra hours are provided with via accommodation 20, then that amount of extra time is provided each day.
