## **Graduation Rates**



In accordance with 34 C.F.R. 200.19(b) and MS Code Ann. 37-17-6, graduation rates are calculated following the four-year adjusted cohort method.

- Four-Year Cohort: a group of students who enter 9<sup>th</sup> grade in MS for the first time, adjusted for students transferring into and out of the cohort, and are expected to graduate within four years
  - Graduate
  - Completer
  - Still Enrolled
  - Dropout



#### Graduate:

- A student receiving a Traditional Diploma in four years
- A student receiving a Traditional Diploma with endorsements in four years (Academic, Distinguished Academic, Career and Technical)
- A student receiving an alternate diploma as outlined in Appendix A-10 prior to reaching the maximum age for services
  - Students on track to earn an Alternate Diploma may have their cohort assignment adjusted if they continue beyond the fourth year of their original cohort.
    - \*\*\*Enrolled in Grade 12 NOT Grade 13



#### Completer:

- A student receiving a district-issued GED
- A student receiving a Certificate of Completion as outlined in Appendix A-11
- A student who has successfully completed all Carnegie unit requirements for graduation but has not passed one or more EOC assessments or met a graduation option in *Appendix A-5*



#### Still Enrolled:

 A student who is still enrolled in September the year after the cohort's expected completion date



#### Dropout:

- A student who leaves school without earning a diploma, certificate, or legitimately transferring to an accredited public or non-public school program resulting in a high school diploma
- Students transferring to a community-based GED program are considered dropouts



- Entering a cohort:
  - Any enrollment with their grade-level peers
- Leaving a cohort
  - Transfer to nonpublic school, out of state/country, home school, or deceased
- Students are assigned to the school/district of longest enrollment (separately).



- Students who are ungraded (Grades 56, 58, 78) are placed in a cohort based on their peer age (age as of September 1).
  - 14 Grade 9
  - 15 Grade 10
  - 16 Grade 11
  - 17 Grade 12
- Cohort assignments for ungraded students are unrelated to where students are physically enrolled/served.



#### October 31 – Cohort Deadline

- This is the final opportunity to review and update the official record in MSIS for the prior academic year. After October 31, the prior year's academic record is considered permanent and final.
- This deadline applies to all four active cohorts during the 2024-2025 academic year.
- Students with a "Dropout" status and "Last Enrollment" date prior to the 2024-2025 school year cannot be removed from the cohort.



- Adjustments are made to the full cohort group to account for those students who are deceased or transfer to other educational settings outside of Mississippi's public-school system
- A valid transfer may include the following:
  - Transfer to a non-public school
  - Transfer to Home School
  - Transfer out of the State/Country

# Cohort



## Cohorts are used to calculate Graduation Rate for Accountability purposes.

A student enters a cohort when they enroll in 9th grade for the first time. Once a student is placed in a cohort group, they remain in the cohort regardless of whether they repeat or skip a grade level during the four-year period.

Students who enter a Mississippi public school in a grade higher than 9th grade (or peer grade equivalent higher than 9th grade) are placed in the same cohort as their peer group. A student transferring from a private/non-public school to a Mississippi public school in Grades 10, 11, or 12 will be placed in the same cohort group as the current students in Grades 10, 11, or 12.

#### **Final Status Indicators**

At the end of the four-year tracking period, the entire set of MSIS data pertaining to the student will be examined chronologically (from the earliest available recorded events to the latest), and any "final disposition" events will be identified.

Final disposition events captured by the system include dropouts, documented transfers out-of-state, documented transfers to a non-public school, death, and school completion. Transfers within the public school system are not considered transfer events.

It is the responsibility of the school/district of final enrollment to ensure that the final status of the student is correct, regardless of the student's final status assignment.
