

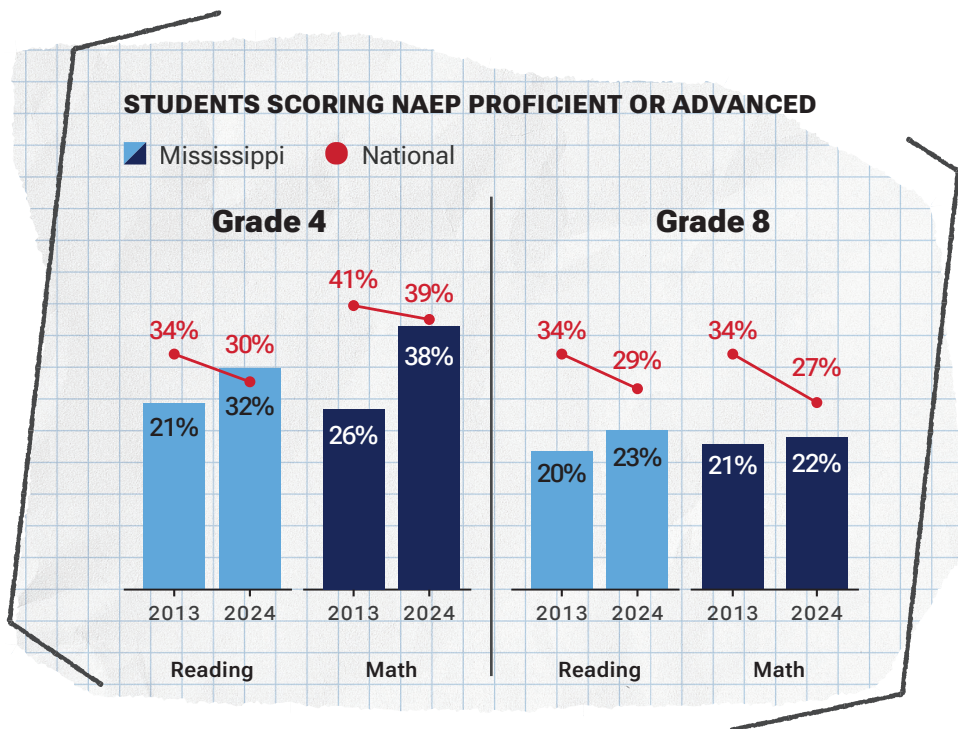
Mississippi's 2024

National Assessment of Educational Progress

Mississippi achieved its highest-ever rates of students scoring proficient or advanced in all four NAEP tested grades and subjects.

The percentage of grade 4 students scoring proficient or advanced in reading exceeds the national average. In grade 4 math, the percentage of students scoring proficient or advanced is statistically tied to the nation's average.

Mississippi is one of only a few states with improved NAEP scores since 2013. In most states, NAEP scores have been falling over the past decade.

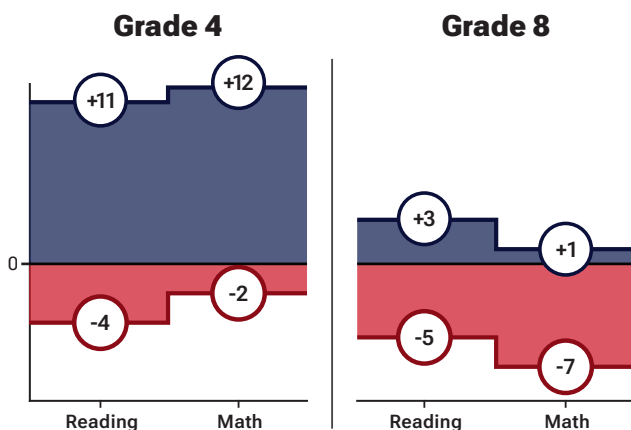
