
The State Agency (SA) completed an Administrative Review (AR) of the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program (SBP) during the week of January 27, 2025. An exit conference was conducted on February 20, 2025. The SA is pleased to report that over the course of the Review, **no findings were identified**. We are closing the district's file for this review period. No response is necessary.

In addition to conducting the AR, one of the functions of the SA is to provide Technical Assistance (TA). During the course of the review, the SA Reviewer provided TA in several areas to the Child Nutrition Director (CND). TA is documented in MARS, specifically in the "Technical Assistance" section of the "Compliance" Module. TA is provided for the improvement of the program operations and is not considered a finding.

Mr. Davis and his staff are to be commended for their dedication to providing attractive, nutritious meals to the students of Lafayette County. The Reviewer was impressed with the cleanliness of the kitchens and dining halls, and also with the care shown to students by the cafeteria staff. All required records were well-organized and readily available for review. All staff were welcoming and kind, which made time spent in the schools a pleasure.
